- 1. Sponsorship will only be secured once the application registration form and deposit has been received. Please see Sponsorship Packages and email events@dermalclinicians.com.au
- 2. An email of confirmation including tax invoice of remaining amount will be issued. See attached schedule of dates for payment
- 3. Payments can be made through the website by credit card with PayPal facility or to the ASDC bank account. Details are provided in the schedule of dates for payment.
- 4. Exhibitions space will be allocated on first in first served basis upon receiving booking form once exhibition space map has been provided.
- 5. To secure your sponsorship we require \$500 initial upfront payment, via our website on your chosen package. There will then be two dates for remaining payments that must be received (and cleared by bank) according to the attached schedule of payments.

No sponsor will be permitted to enter the exhibition hall or be listed as a sponsor on the ASDC website, advertising materials or conference program until full payment and a booking form has been received by the ASDC.

- 6. CANCELLATION POLICY. In the event of cancellation. The \$500 reservation will not be refunded and a service fee of 30% of the sponsorship package cost applies for cancellations prior to June 1st 2021 and 50% from June 1 to June 30 2021. No refunds will be made for cancellations after June 30th 2021. And full payment is required. Should a cancellation be made prior to receipt of final payment, the deposit will be held as cancellation fee. After sponsorship has been confirmed and accepted, a reduction in sponsorship is considered a cancellation and will be governed by the above cancellation policy.
- 7. No sponsor shall assign, sublet or apportion the whole or any part of their sponsorship package except upon prior written consent of the Conference Managers.
